Concert Attire:

All students are expected to have the following items for all performances:

- All black collared shirt (ties optional) & slacks. Girls may wear black dresses. Solid black dress shoes & socks.

Chorus

Students are expected to come prepared for class each day with the following:

- One 1-inch or 1/2-inch three-ring binder (hard cover).
- Music (provided in class).
- A single subject three-hole punched notebook just for chorus (to be placed in the binder).
- Pencils & highlighters

Concert Attire:

All students are expected to have the following items for all performances:

- Solid black dress pants. No jeans/jeggings/leggings/skirts/etc...
- Solid black (closed-toed) shoes. (Black socks, if socks are appropriate to be worn with the shoes.)
- A JHMS Chorus Polo (Sport-Tek Sideblock, Navy Blue & Gold, with the choir logo), purchasable at the beginning of the school year.

Band

You will need the following supplies in class every day:

- A pencil.
- Your Method Book.
 - **6th Grade Band** Method Book – Essential Elements (2000) Book 1 (book w/yellow stripe at top)
 - **7th & 8th Grade Band** Method Book – Essential Elements (2000) Book 2 (book w/red stripe at top)
- Music
- Supplies.
 - A metronome or metronome/tuner (home practice and concert warm-up)
 - *All Woodwinds* – **at least 3 good reeds**, swab or cleaning cloth, cork grease and key oil.
 - *All Brasswinds* – Any necessary lubricants, cleaning cloth, snake, and mute (when required)
 - *All Percussion* – Vic Firth EP2 Intermediate Education Pack, containing one pair snare sticks (SD2), 2 pairs of mallets (M3 & M6), 1 pair of timpani mallets (T3), and a carrying bag. A drum or practice pad *and* bells are needed for home practice.
 - **7th & 8th Grade Students** – A portable folding music stand (home practice and concert tours).
- Instrument (beginning on the 3rd day of school). If you need a rental, please make arrangements *before* the start of the school year.

Suggested Supplies for increasing ability and level of success:

- Additional non-class method/music book for your instrument.

	Better:	Vandoren B45 mp, Mitchell Lurie Medium (#3) reeds.
Saxes	Good:	Hite “Premiere” mp, Rovner “Dark” ligature, and LaVoz reeds (medium).
	Better:	Selmer Paris Prologue mp and Vandoren Medium (#3) reeds.
Trumpets		Bach 5C mp and “Blue Juice” valve oil.
Trombones		Bach 5G mp, “Trombonetine” slide cream, and a trombone spray bottle.
Percussion		Ludwig/Musser LMXYL0 Kit 2.5 Octave Xylophone/Percussion Pad Kit
