A final decision will be made, and announced at our May 5th PTO Meeting. I hope to see you there.

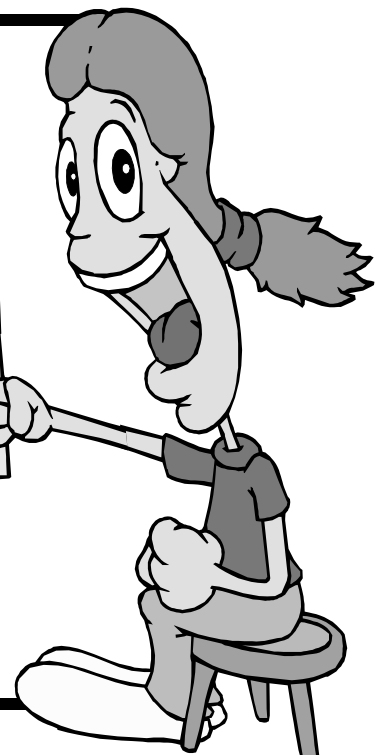
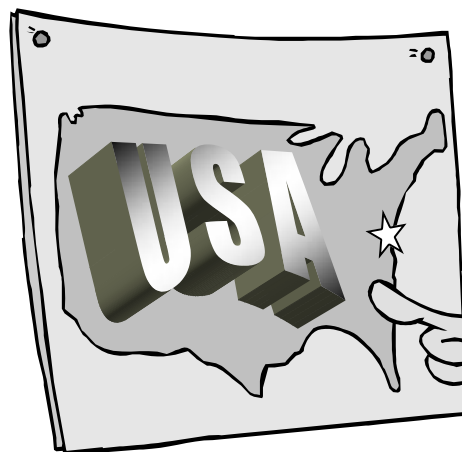

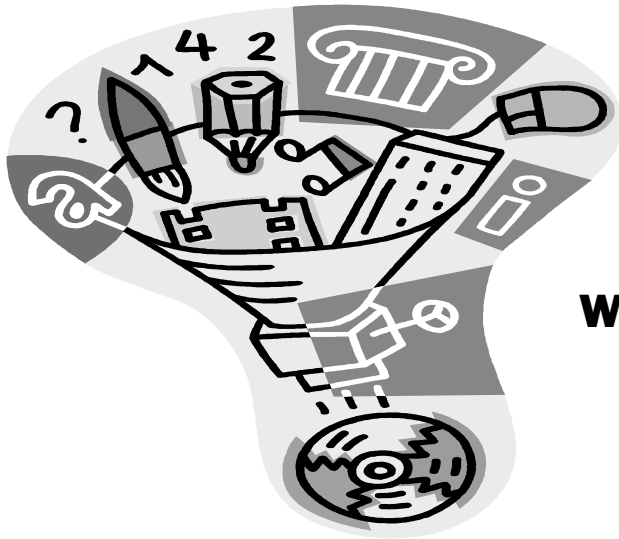
