Elementary School Redistricting

Redistricting Overview

Elementary school boundaries will change as Charles County Public Schools prepares to open William A. Diggs Elementary School in Waldorf. Two alternatives have been developed to create an attendance zone for Diggs and to more evenly distribute the student populations among other elementary schools. A public hearing to gather community input is scheduled for Feb. 28, 7 p.m., at Westlake High School.

Attendance zones for the following elementary schools could change with the opening of Diggs: J.C. Parks, Gale-Bailey, Arthur Middleton, Dr. James Craik, Daniel of St. Thomas Jenifer, Berry and Indian Head. Affected elementary school students will change schools in August 2006.

Alternative A

This proposal impacts students at Parks, Craik, Berry, Jenifer and Middleton elementary schools.

• **Moves from Parks to Diggs:** All students living along or directly off Bensville Road from the corner of Bensville Road at Billingsley Road to the point where Bensville Road meets with Shannon Drive. Includes students residing on or directly off Billingsley Road from the corner of Billingsley Road at Bensville Road to the entrance of Kingsview subdivision on Billingsley Road.

Communities impacted but not limited to: Kingsview, Highgrove, Foxhall Estates, Billingsley Forest, Countryside, Quiet Acres, Singing Hills, Shady Acres, Twinbrook Estates, Settle Woods, Eutaw Forest, Phillips Meadow, Cartegena Highlands and Friendship Estates

• **Moves from Parks to Craik:** All students residing along or directly off Billingsley Road from the corner of Billingsley Road at Middletown Road to the point where Billingsley Road intersects with Bensville Road. Includes students residing on or directly off Bensville Road southbound from the corner of Bensville Road at Billingsley Road.

Communities impacted but not limited to: Billingsley Park, Spring Valley, Robie Manor, Tarrington Creek and Brookwood Estates

• **Moves from Parks to Berry:** All students residing along or directly off of Middletown Road from the corner of Middletown Road at Billingsley Road to the point where Middletown Road intersects with Smallwood Drive.

• **Moves from Middleton to Berry:** All students residing along or directly off of Billingsley Road from the corner of Billingsley Road at Crain Highway South to the point where Billingsley Road intersects with Middletown Road. Crain Highway South in Block 3861 at Tower shopping center day-cares.

Communities impacted but not limited to: Aspen Woods, Southwinds, Greenhaven Run and Worthington

• **Moves from Jenifer to Berry:** All students residing along or directly off of Berry Road westbound directly across from Sun Valley Drive up to Community Drive.

Communities impacted but not limited to: Hunt Club Estates, Fox Run and Westwood Estates

• **Moves from Berry to Diggs:** All students residing along or directly off Bensville Road from the corner of Bensville Road at Shannon Drive to the point where Bensville Road intersects with Berry Road. Includes students residing on or directly off Berry Road from the intersection of Berry Road at Bensville Road to the intersection of Berry Road at Middletown Road.

Communities impacted but not limited to: Laurel Branch, Berry Hill Manor, Audrey Manor, Wellington Woods, Stone Ridge, Mill Hill Road Area, Somerset, Berry Valley, Briarwood, Greenmont and Meadowland

Alternative B

This proposal impacts students at Parks, Berry, Middleton, Jenifer, Gale-Bailey and Indian Head elementary schools.

• **Moves from Parks to Diggs:** All students residing along or directly off of Bensville Road from the corner of Bensville Road at Billingsley Road to the point where Bensville Road meets with Shannon Drive. Includes students residing on or directly off Billingsley Road from the corner of Billingsley Road at Bensville Road to the entrance of Kingsview subdivision on Billingsley Road. All students residing along or directly off Billingsley Road from the corner of Billingsley Road at Middletown Road to the point where Billingsley Road intersects with Bensville Road. All students residing on or directly off Bensville Road southbound from the corner of Bensville Road at Billingsley Road.

Communities impacted but not limited to: Kingsview, Highgrove, Foxhall Estates, Billingsley Forest, Countryside, Quiet Acres, Singing Hills, Shady Acres, Twinbrook Estates, Settle Woods, Eutaw Forest, Phillips Meadow, Cartegena Highlands, Friendship Estates, Billingsley Park, Spring Valley, Robie Manor and Tarrington Creek

• **Moves from Parks to Berry:** Also, includes students residing along or directly off Middletown Road beginning at the railroad tracks on Middletown Road north of Marshall Corner Road to the intersection of Middletown Road at Smallwood Drive.

• **Moves from Berry to Diggs:** All students residing along or directly off Bensville Road from the corner of Bensville Road at Shannon Drive to the point where Bensville Road intersects with Berry Road. Includes students residing on or directly off Berry Road from the intersection of Berry Road at Bensville Road to the intersection of Berry Road at Middletown Road.

Communities impacted, but not limited to: Laurel Branch, Berry Hill Manor, Audrey Manor, Wellington Woods, Stone Ridge, Mill Hill Road Area, Somerset, Berry Valley, Briarwood, Greenmont and Meadowland

• **Moves from Middleton to Berry:** All students residing along or directly off of Billingsley Road from the corner of Billingsley Road at St. Patrick's Drive to the point where Billingsley Road intersects with Middletown Road.

Communities impacted but not limited to: Greenhaven Run and Worthington

• **Moves from Jenifer to Berry:** Includes all students residing along or directly off Berry Road, westbound beginning at the intersection of Berry Road at Hamilton up to Community Drive, which

includes all subdivisions and communities along or directly off the western side of Hamilton Road. Included are all subdivisions and communities along or directly off Acton Lane beginning at the intersection of Acton Lane at Hamilton Road, westbound to the Charles/Prince George's County line.

Communities impacted but not limited to: Hunt Club Estates, Fox Run, Westwood Estates, Springhaven, Springhaven Woods, Rolling Meadows, Wexford Village (community on the western side of Hamilton Road), Wexford Village (Gates Place area), Cedarbrook and Hamilton Estates

• **Moves from Middleton to Jenifer:** All students residing along or directly off Berry Road, eastbound from the corner of Berry Road at Marsh Hawk Drive to Crain Highway. Includes students residing along or directly off Western Parkway from the corner of Western Parkway at Berry Road, southbound to the corner of Western Parkway at St. Patrick's Drive Billingsley Road at St. Patrick's Drive to the point where Billingsley Road intersects with Middletown Road.

Communities impacted but not limited to: Millbrook (both communities) and Victoria Park

• **Moves from Parks to Indian Head:** All students residing along or directly off Indian Head Highway, southbound from the corner of Indian Head Highway, south at Glymont Road to the Town of Indian Head line (after Cedar Lane).

Communities impacted, but not limited to: Potomac Heights

• **Moves from Gale-Bailey to Parks:** All students residing along or directly off Livingston Road beginning at the corner of Livingston Road at Hawthorne Road to the corner of Livingston Road at Bumpy Oak Road. Includes students residing along or directly off Bumpy Oak Road beginning at the corner of Bumpy Oak Road at Livingston Road to the end of the Gale-Bailey zone south of Ashland Road.

Communities impacted but not limited to: Ashland Road area and Livingston Road area from Hawthorne Road to Bumpy Oak Road

How will comments be received?

Community input is essential to a successful redistricting. Two public hearings are scheduled on Feb. 28 and March 29.
