# HIGH SCHOOL COURSE REQUEST PROCESS FOR THE 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR

- Our new student information system facilitates parent and student involvement in requesting courses for next school year. Current students in grades 5 through 11 can request courses for next year using their StudentVue account.
- Parents can assist their child by using their ParentVue account to select courses.
- Current 5<sup>th</sup> through 7<sup>th</sup> graders will be able to select and prioritize elective classes.
- Current and rising high schoolers will have required courses pre-assigned and will request main classes and electives.

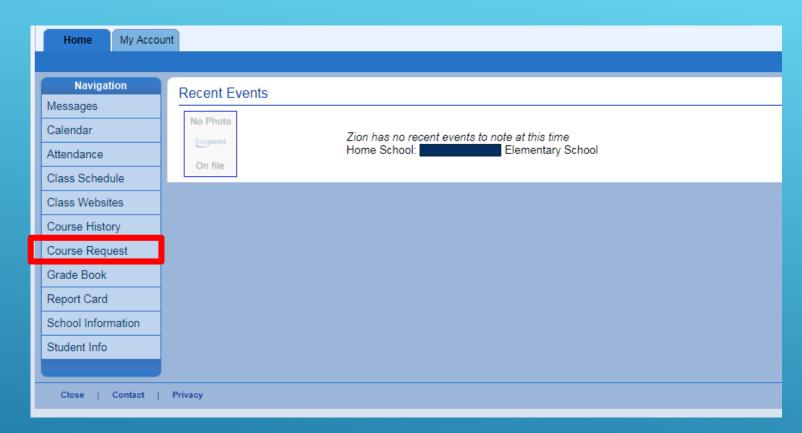
#### WHAT ARE ONLINE COURSE REQUESTS?

- ► Each middle and high school will open the course request tab in StudentVue and ParentVue for selecting courses.
- Schools will inform parents and students of this time window, but generally the course selection process will take place annually in February.

## WHEN WILL THE ONLINE COURSE REQUEST HAPPEN

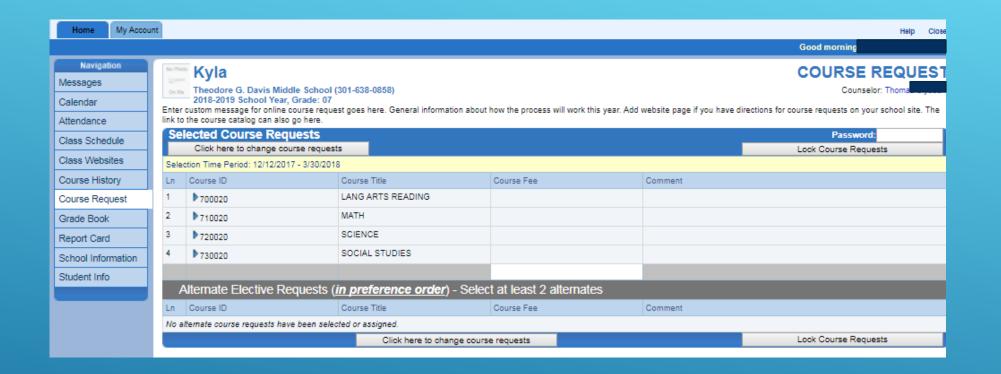
- Students will use their StudentVue account to select courses for next year during school with the assistance of the school staff.
- Most schools will send home a course selection sheet for students and parents to choose courses for next year.
- Most students will then bring the course selection sheet to the computer lab for requesting courses via StudentVue.
- Alternatively, students and parents can select the courses using their StudentVue or ParentVue account from home. School staff will verify the selection with the student during the school day.

## HOW TO REQUEST COURSES FOR 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR

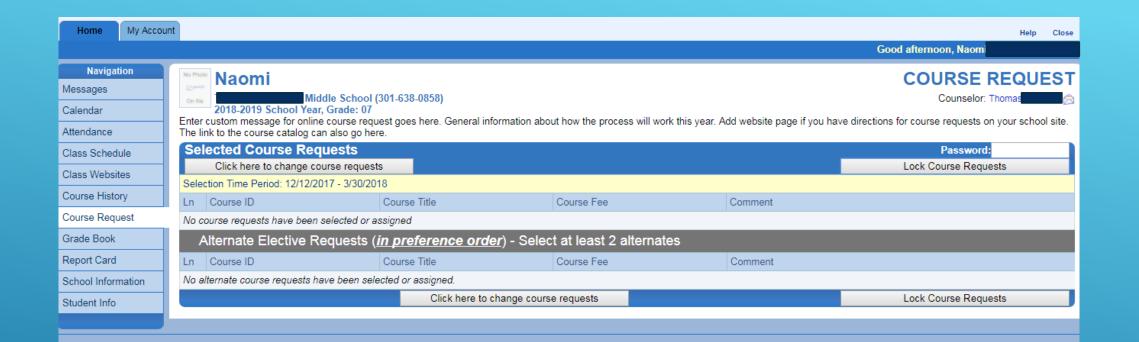


Students use their StudentVue or parents can use their ParentVue accounts to enter their course requests for next year online. During the online course selection window, the Course Request tab appears.

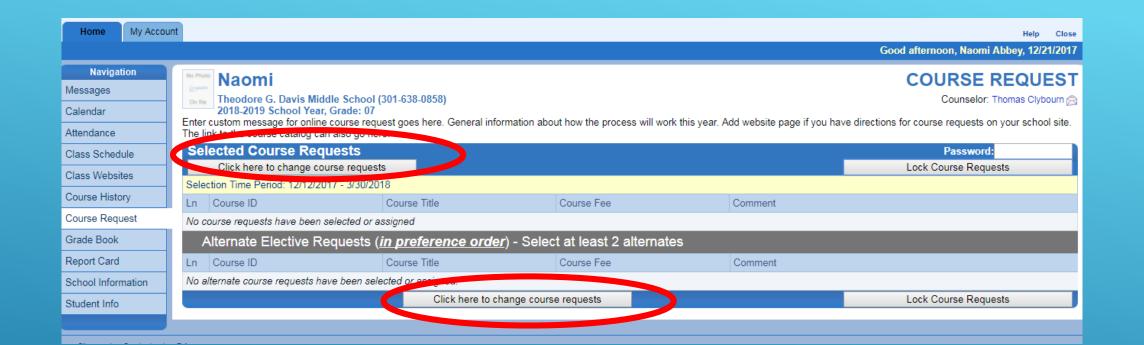
Click the course request tab to begin the online course request process.



If the student has been pre-assigned to classes, the course request screen will look similar to this.

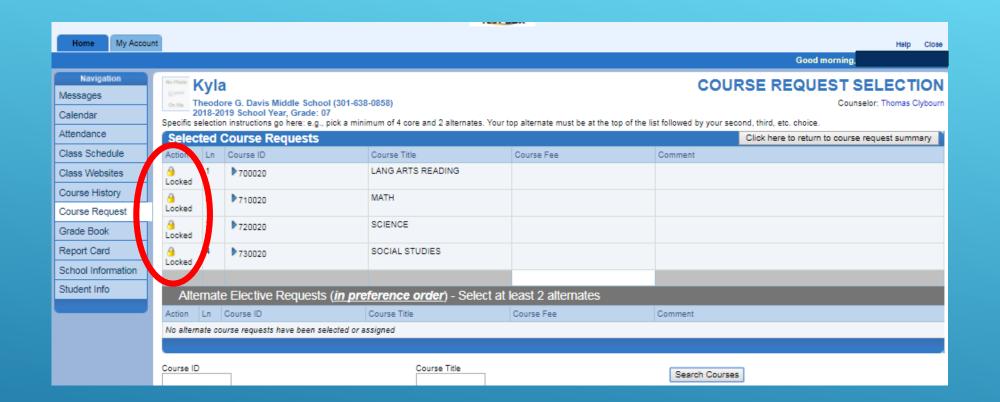


If the student has not been pre-registered for core classes, the screen will look like this.

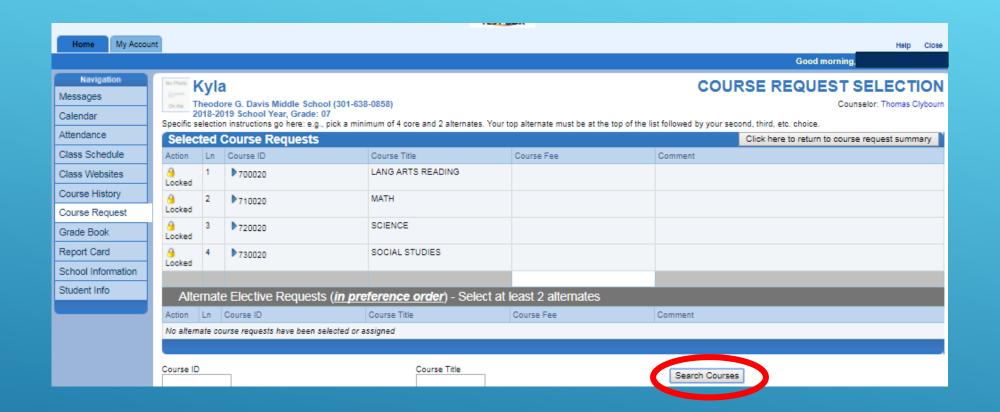


To begin selecting courses for next year, click the button. That brings up the next screen for picking classes.

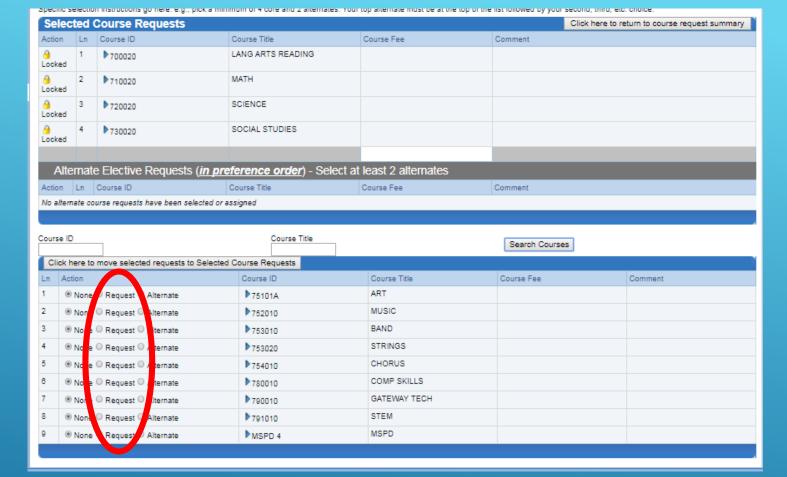
Click here to change course requests



If the school staff has locked courses into place for next school year, you will see a padlock next those courses. These classes cannot be changed by parents or students. School staff has suggested these courses and can alter them if necessary.



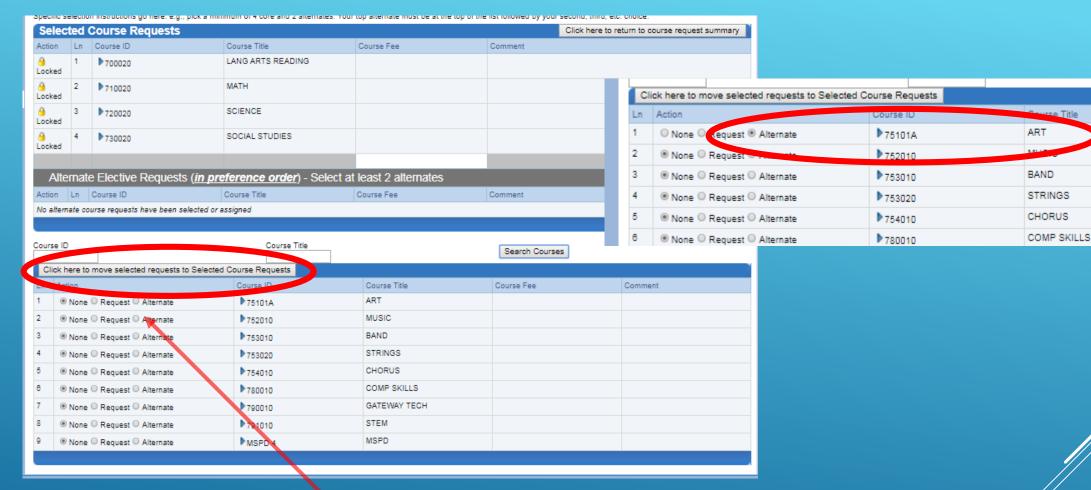
Click the Search Courses button to see a list of possible courses for the student.



High school students will click the request button for selecting core classes, such as required courses, or other main courses such as band, chorus, or Advanced Placement (AP) classes.

These core courses can all be selected at once. For example you can select chords, AP Biology and French II at one time.

#### Electives must be selected one at a time to ensure the correct priority order



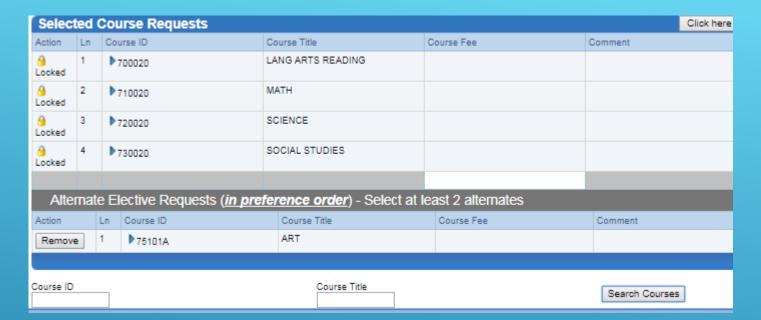
Students will click the Alternate button for selecting electives.

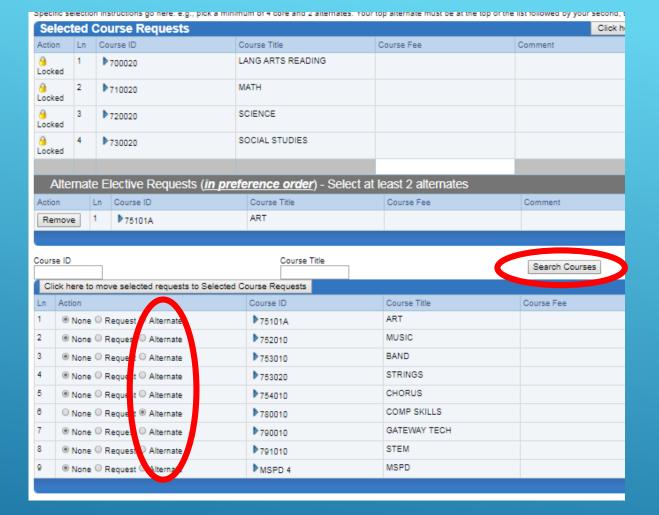

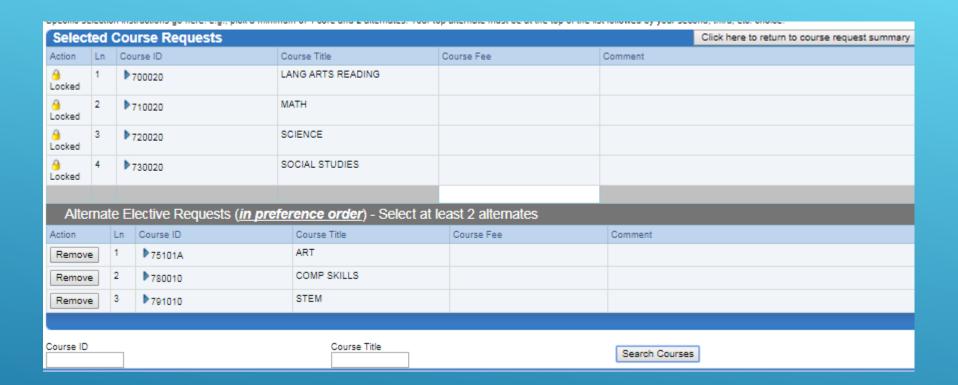
The course is moved to the requested course list and the course is the student's elective first priority.

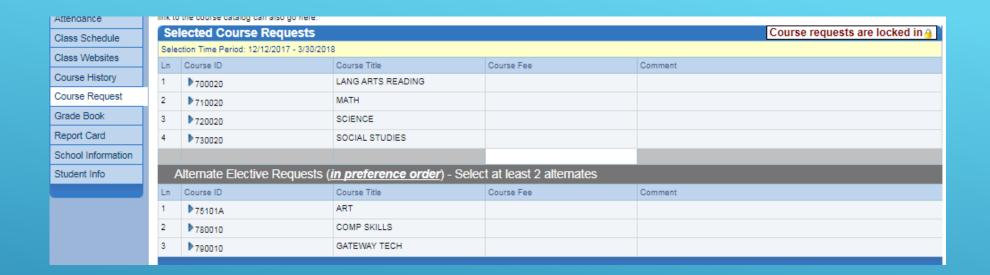
