Delegate Scholarship Application

Dear Student,

PLEASE READ OVER THIS COVER PAGE CAREFULLY AS SOME CHANGES HAVE BEEN MADE TO THIS YEAR'S 2023-2024 APPLICATION PACKET:

- All applicants will be required to submit their application via **EMAIL ONLY** to the email address listed above. **Mailed/Faxed applications will not be accepted due to the in-office absence of staff.**
- **This** office will be accepting the submission of **unofficial** transcripts in lieu of official transcripts until further notice. **All Transcripts must be from your school, not non-descript downloaded printouts.**

To be eligible for a Delegate Scholarship, you must meet the following criteria:

- (1) **Be a resident of Charles County Maryland (District 28 residents only).**
- (2) **You must attend or plan on attending a Maryland college or university or have your academic major approved "Unique" by the Maryland Higher Education Commission if you attend an out of state school otherwise you are ineligible for a Delegate Scholarship award.**
- (3) **File an application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) before applying.**
- (4) **Apply for admission to a Maryland college, university or other accredited post-secondary educational program as a full-time or part-time student.**

You must also, complete a **FULL (1) ONE PAGE ESSAY** outlining why you feel you should receive this scholarship and submit an **UNOFFICIAL** transcript of your grades. These items **MUST** be forwarded **with** the completed application in order to be considered by the scholarship committee. **ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE EMAILED TO THIS OFFICE BY THE CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON APRIL 3, 2023(5:00PM).** Any applications found to be incomplete, out of district or submitted after the deadline will not be considered, so please complete **ALL** fields on the application in its entirety **including social security numbers and parental income.**
