College/ University	Credits	Scholarship
Bowie State University	3 credits for EDUC 316 Foundations of Education	No specific scholarship is set aside for TAM students; however, financial aid is available for those who qualify.
College of Southern Maryland (CSM)	3 credits for TED 2030 – Introduction to Education CSM offers credit transfer agreements to Bowie State, Notre Dame of Maryland, and Towson Universities for completion of a 4-year degree in Education.	No specific scholarship is set aside for TAM students; however, financial aid is available for those who qualify.
Coppin State University	3 credits for EDUC 200 History of Education	Provides a \$500 scholarship per semester up to 8 semesters of undergraduate study based upon specific requirements in the agreement.
Frostburg State University	6 credits total: 3 for EDUC 201 : Students, Teachers and Learning Environments and 3 for EDUC 202: Foundations of Learning and Instruction	No specific scholarship is set aside for TAM students; however, financial aid is available for those who qualify.
Hood College	3 credits as EDUC 204 – Foundations of Education in a Diverse Society, a required pre-requisite education course	Provides a \$1,500 scholarship per semester up to 8 semesters of undergraduate study based upon specific requirements in the agreement
McDaniel College	No credits are offered at this time.	\$10,000 per year for TAM students. Note: McDaniel does not stack the TAM scholarship on top of any other scholarship, so if the student is eligible for a different scholarship with a higher value, the student will only receive the highest valued award.

Morgan State University	3 credits for EDUC 200 – Foundations of Education and Teaching	No specific scholarship is set aside for TAM students however financial aid is available for those who qualify.
Saint Mary's College of Maryland	4 credits for EDUC 140: Special Topics in Educational Studies	Provides a \$500 scholarship per semester up to 8 semesters of undergraduate study based upon specific requirements in the agreement.
Salisbury University	3 credits EDUC 210 School in a Diverse Society, a required pre-program course for secondary education majors <u>OR</u> 1 credit as ELED 201 Introduction to Teaching plus 2 credits of electives for elementary and early childhood education majors	Provides a \$500 scholarship per semester up to 8 semesters of undergraduate study based upon specific requirements in the agreement.
Stevenson University	3 credits for PSY 206 Child Growth and Development For Early Childhood Majors: 3 credits for PSY 206 Child Growth and Development and 3 credits as ED 108/ED 108F Learning Experiences/Field Experience	No specific scholarship is set aside for TAM students; however, financial aid is available for those who qualify.
Towson University	3 credits for EDUC 202 Historical Contemporary Perspectives on America's Urban Schools	Provides a \$500 scholarship per semester up to 8 semesters of undergraduate study based upon specific requirements in the agreement.

Note to students: nearly all agreements have minimum GPA requirements in the TAM program of study in order to qualify for the above mentioned credits and scholarships. This typically includes a minimum grade required in each of the four TAM courses in addition to overall GPA.
