

What is Bookshare?

Bookshare.org is a repository of books in digital format for eligible students. Eligible students are those who are unable to read standard print because of a visual impairment, physical impairment, or learning disability, such as Dyslexia.

When to use Bookshare:

Use Bookshare to ensure that eligible students who use assistive technology to read have timely access to copyrighted materials in the format they need.

- Teachers use Bookshare to provide books to students who need a digital version of novels or text books for school.
 - Teacher must become a Sponsor on Bookshare to obtain digital books for eligible students
 - Email Diane Bicknell, Assistive Technology Professional (<u>dbicknell@ccboe.com</u>) to be added as a Sponsor for CCPS.
 - Teachers complete and sign a Bookshare Proof of Disability Form for each eligible student. A parent or guardian must also sign this form to give consent to share the student's information with Bookshare.
 - Send completed proof of disability forms to <u>dbicknell@ccboe.com</u>

- Parents can also help students access any book they like through an Individual Membership.
 - When students are added as Bookshare members, an email can be sent to them through Bookshare to invite individual membership

How to get books from Bookshare:

There are three easy options for getting teachers and students started with Bookshare.

- A: Teacher Supported--Teachers download books and provide them to students through the student's OneDrive or a thumb drive (if internet access is not available).
- B: Teacher Guided--Teachers provide students with a login to Bookshare Web Reader. Students are limited to books on their reading list.
- **C: Individual**--Parents obtain an Individual Membership so that students can find and download books for themselves.

How to read books from Bookshare:

In CCPS, most students use one of the following tools to read books from Bookshare:

- Bookshare Web Reader is a web-based viewer and reader that is accessed through Bookshare.org.
