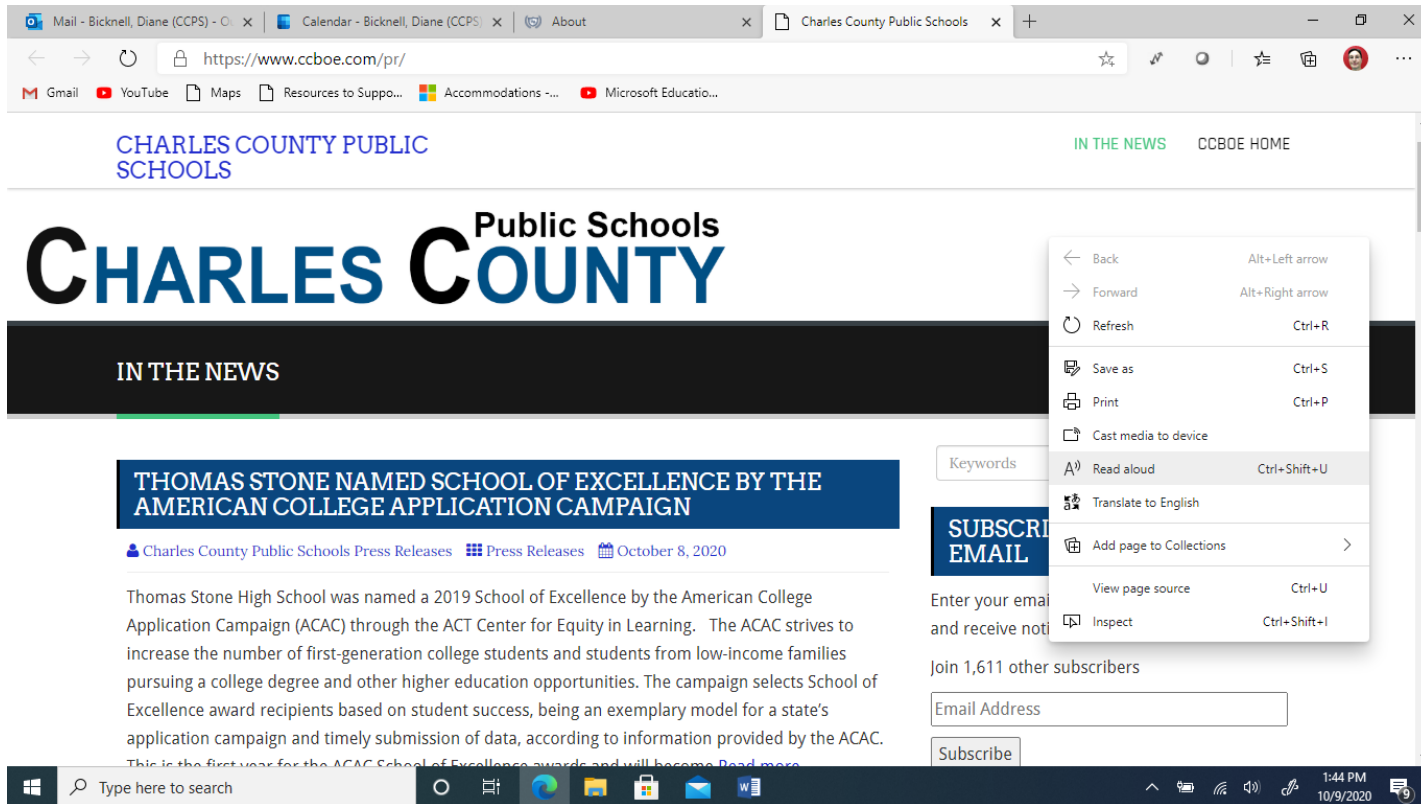


Text-To-Speech Screen Reader Tool in Edge Browser

1. The student logs onto the internet using Edge as the browser.
2. Right click somewhere on the screen and choose “Read Aloud” from the menu.



- The screen reader tool bar will be added to the top of the screen so students can pause, rewind and fast-forward the audio. As the screen reader reads the text, the row is highlighted in blue and the word is highlighted in yellow.
