

CCPS 2021 Winter Chess Tournament Covid-19 Questionnaire

Parents/Guardians,

Thank you for registering your child for the 2021 Winter Chess Tournament. We need your help to check your child's health the morning of the tournament before they enter Henry E. Lackey High School on February 20, 2021. By sending your child to the tournament, you indicate you have screened your child, and he/she is not a potential positive COVID-19 case. A child who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past two weeks, who is suffering from an upper or lower respiratory illness, or had close contact with an ill person who has tested positive for COVID-19 should stay home.

"Close contact" is defined as being within six feet of a positive person for more than 15 minutes during a 24-hour period. Close contact would also include sharing a drink or utensils, kissing, hugging, or a sick person coughing or sneezing directly on you.

People with COVID-19 have reported a wide range of symptoms. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), people with the below symptoms may have COVID-19. The most common symptom of COVID 19 for school-aged children is a fever and cough. If your child displays two or more of the below symptoms, your child should stay home and your family medical care provider should be contacted. The CDC suggests parents should pay particular attention to the symptoms labeled with an asterisk *.

* New uncontrollable cough that causes difficulty breathing	Y/N
