

Life Skills Supply List 2019-2020

Children participating in the Life Skills program often require different supplies than those in full-time general education programs. Following is a list of supplies for students in the Life Skills program. You do not need to purchase the supplies for your child's grade level on the standard supply list.

- A full change of clothes (Clothes should fit well and be seasonally appropriate. Clothes will be sent home to be exchanged as the seasons change.)
- Diapers/pull-ups
- Baby/sanitary wipes
- Classroom snacks (Whatever your child prefers. Snacks will be needed on an ongoing basis for our daily snack time, during which we work on communication, social, and independent living skills.)

All of the above supplies will be labeled with your child's name for their use only.

Gloves will be provided for staff use if needed for toileting or injury. Please let us know if your child has an allergy or sensitivity to latex. Non-latex gloves can be obtained.

A note will be sent home to request new hygiene items as needed. Parents may choose to send in extras at the beginning of the year to be saved for later use.



**Students will have a homeroom class and will travel to different classes each day. They will need their supplies IN THEIR BINDERS. Extra supplies will be housed in the child's homeroom.

- One 3" binder

- 1 pack of dividers (set of 3)
- 5 packs of wide-ruled loose-leaf paper (reinforced holes, if possible)
- 5 folders (3-hole punched, any color)
- 5 Journals
- Pencils (Ticonderoga last the longest!)
- 12 glue sticks
- 1 pair of student scissors
- 2 packs of sticky notes

- 1 or 2 highlighters
