What We're Learning in October in Second Grade

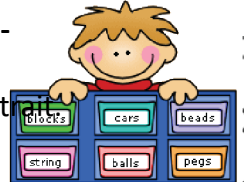
This month, in reading, we will be reading both fiction and informational texts. We will also be focusing on using information from the illustrations and words to demonstrate understanding of the texts and acknowledging differences in points of views of the characters. Scholars will be writing both informational and opinion pieces this month. We are focusing on using capitalization, punctuation and complete sentences.

In math, we will be solving a variety of word problems, as well as adding and subtracting within one hundred. Please keep practicing these addition and subtraction facts at home. Students should review adding and subtracting ones, twos, and tens. They need to keep practicing counting on and back strategies, such as starting at the largest number in the equation and counting on or back.

In Social Studies, we will be describing how consumers acquire goods and services and explain why people have to make economic choices.

Finally, our core value for this month is **Integrity** - choosing to be truthful in whatever you say and do.
