

PARKING REMINDERS

1. Know and adhere to the rules.
2. Speed limit on campus is 10 MPH.
3. Hang tags **must** be displayed from the mirror as you enter school grounds.
4. Park in your assigned space only.
5. **Arrive prior to 7:20 AM and be in homeroom on time. Chronic absenteeism and/or tardiness will result in revocation of driving privileges.**
6. Do not drive anyone in your car that has not been registered with the administrator.
7. You may not park in any other area besides the student parking lot nor on any other CCBOE property while in attendance at SCHS for the school day.
8. **Notes signed by a parent or guardian requesting an early dismissal for student drivers must be brought to the attendance office *before* homeroom and must include a contact number where a parent can be reached for verification. All early dismissal requests must be verified by a parent/guardian.**
9. All students must supply a note for the absence or tardy upon return to SCHS. If late to school, drivers must enter through the main office doors and check in at the attendance desk.
10. Be courteous and drive safely!!!

Late to school/unlawful absence	6th Tardy: Loss of driving privilege for the remainder of quarter	12th Tardy: Loss of driving privilege for the remainder of school year
Park only in designated parking spot	Loss of driving privilege for the remainder of quarter	Loss of driving privilege for the remainder of school year
